Dear Dr. Wagner,

Thank you for requesting evaluation of Viking Caywood at your clinic. Viking Caywood was evaluated on September 03, 2026. The pertinent facts of the case are:

History:

New Mobile Cardiology Consultation - Drop Off

History: Viking presented for a routine examination. There are no clinical signs of heart disease at this time.

Current Medications: None

Examination & Diagnostic Testing:**Physical Examination (Cardiac Specific)**

Physical examination demonstrated no cardiac murmur. A heart rate of 200 beats per minute was obtained and femoral pulses were within normal limits. Respiratory rate and character were within normal limits (30-40 bpm).

Echocardiography

Echocardiography demonstrated left ventricular wall and chamber dimensions as well as left atrial dimensions to be within normal limits. Right side chambers and valves were within normal limits. There were no heartworms noted in visible portions of the pulmonary arteries. Color Doppler and pulsed-wave Doppler echocardiography demonstrated no turbulent flow.

Assessment:

There is no echocardiographic evidence of clinically significant structural heart disease.

Recommendations:

Further Diagnostic Tests: N/A

Medications: There is no indication for cardiac medications at this time.

Diet: A standard diet should be provided.

Exercise: Normal activity may be allowed.

Recheck/Comments:

Routine screenings may be considered as indicated.

Anesthesia: I see no echocardiographic contraindication for anesthesia if planned at this time so long as preoperative blood work and electrocardiography are within normal limits and no clinical signs noted and the owner aware of risks. Standard accepted protocols should be applied.

Additional Notes: A recheck echocardiogram may be considered yearly to every other year to continue to rule out development of acquired heart disease, or sooner if clinical signs of congestive heart failure were noted or a cardiac murmur developed.
